What is the Digital Services Act?

The Digital Services Act is a digital regulation created by the European Union. The act went into effect on the 16th of November 2022 and introduced new provisions that allow the EU to designate entities to "very large online platforms" (VLOP) and "very large online search engines" (VLOSE). Additionally, the act provides new business obligations such as the publishing of transparency reports and more. However, the majority of the new provisions added will not go into effect until the 17th of February 2024.

Moreover, these additional provisions include regulations on digital services such as liability, targeted advertising, transparency for users, and management of systematic platform risks.

Article 13

Among these new provisions is article 13 which introduces the appointment of "points of contact & legal representatives". This article establishes that providers that are not based in the European Union must designate a legal representative that is headquartered in an EU member state and provides their service within that state. This designation is required in writing.

Additionally, providers must give the name, postal address, email address, and telephone of their legal representative to the Digital Services Coordinator in the EU state wherein the legal representative is established. This information must be publicly available, accurate, easily accessible, and up to date.
